

YEFIM ROSENFELD: A LOVE FOR LIFE



Yefim Rosenfeld (1922–2013) was born in St. Petersburg, Russia. He grew up and lived there until moving to Stamford, CT in 1991. Yefim participated in World War II (1941-1945) and received multiple medals. After the war, he studied arts at the Academy of Fine Arts in St. Petersburg.

After graduating in 1951 Yefim worked as an interior designer and architect. Yefim devoted all his spare time to creating landscape paintings of the most famous parks around St. Petersburg such as Pavlovsk, Pushkin and Petrodvorets which were the residences of Russian Tsars. He was a frequent participant of numerous art exhibitions organized by the Union of Artists of Russia.
