Barbara Boeck is an honors graduate with a BFA degree from the School of Visual Arts in New York City. Throughout her formative years, she discovered her creativity by experimenting with different mediums. After several years, she embarked on a course of independent study to broaden her horizons and life experience, traveling in Europe, South America, and the United States. Her glasswork can be found in many varied commercial establishments, as well as in numerous private collections. In addition to her functional glasswork, Barbara also creates her personal glasswork within a Fine Art venue. These pieces are deeply carved thick glass panels, freestanding in wooden or metal bases. Her fine art pieces have been exhibited in galleries throughout the U.S. and the tri-state area.
