Sarah Fabian combines techniques rooted in traditional representational drawing, but regularly spills over into related disciplines using etching, charcoal and mixed media. Raised between the East Coast and Hungary, Fabian represents a truly international artist, which translates into her work. Her narrative explores the migrant's story of upheaval, vulnerability, and hope.

Fabian enjoys telling stories through art, using them to give form to ideas that can carry through to our experiences rather than focusing on form alone. As she sees it, "Art is the empowerment of people."

Sarah Fabian's artwork has seen exposure in publications both domestically and internationally. She is also the recipient of the 2005 Community Renewal Team Youth Art Award, a partnership between the National Arts Program and Connecticut's largest community action agency. Her last exhibition was at Norwalk's Center for Contemporary Printmaking in Spring 2013.
