#### DOWNTOWN FOOT PATROL



As warm weather arrives, Stamford Downtown will be abuzz with pedestrians and patrons of Stamford Downtown's many dining options, shops, and open spaces. Stamford Downtown is taking steps to reassure residents, workers, and visitors that Downtown is the safest and most vibrant urban center in the region. To meet this goal, Stamford Downtown has partnered with several Downtown property owners to fund a dedicated foot patrol from the Stamford Police Department. The purpose of this foot patrol is to reinforce the sense of safety along Downtown's main walking streets. The foot patrol will supplement Stamford Downtown's partnership with DOMUS by providing community policing services along the Bedford and Atlantic Street corridor between Veterans Memorial Park and Spring Street. This patrol is scheduled for each weekday between 3:30 P.M. - 7:30 P.M. from the first week of May until the close of June. Stamford Downtown will re-evaluate this schedule before resuming the patrols in July.



**NBC SPORTS AND PARIS OLYMPICS** 

In preparation for the 2024 Paris Olympics (July 26-August 11) which is being broadcast from <u>NBC Sports</u>' headquarters at Chelsea Piers, Stamford Downtown Board Members were offered a tour of the 200,000+ square foot studio facility. Some of the bustle of the complex was noticeable as it was the day before the 150th running of the Kentucky Derby, also broadcast from this location.

Stamford Downtown will continue to partner with NBC Sports as 42 Stamford Downtown businesses are participating in a 10% off discount program for the 2,000 employees coming to Stamford beginning this May to broadcast the <u>2024 Paris Olympics</u>. Stay tuned, as we plan to announce Downtown locations hosting 2024 Paris Olympic viewing parties as the schedule gets released in June.
