The final human touches to an urban masterpiece have been completed.

Throughout Stamford Downtown **18** gardens in **6** parks, **8** parklets and sidewalk gardens, **30** street planters, **3** median dividers and **150** hanging flower baskets have been weeded, fertilized, mulched, pruned and planted.

Each of these broad brush strokes blend and contrast on the downtown canvas to create a work of art that pulses with color, texture and motion through spring, summer and fall.

The artist is Marion Glowka, Landscape Coordinator for Stamford Downtown. Every year since 1994 she has begun in early March with a nearly blank canvas and every year she has created another masterpiece, each better than the last. This year is no exception with significant new treatments in several locations.

Now that summer is nearly here, Marion will continue to weed, feed, water and nurture but then Mother Nature will take over to apply yet another layer of richness to her stunning canvas.
